



PE and Sport Premium

We know that schools have a PE and Sports Premium which must be evidenced on their website. This premium is split into 5 key sections. These are:

1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity
2. The profile of PE and Sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.
3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and Sport.
4. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils.
5. Increased participation in competitive sport.

We believe that rock pooling meets 3 of the 5 indicators (highlighted above), plus we also always discuss beach and water safety, which could also be referred to in your spending plan.

Key indicators 1 and 2 are self-explanatory: getting children outside in the natural environment, clambering over rocks and participating in a conservation-linked project is good for a child's wellbeing and is certainly a physical activity.

Key indicator 3 is met by offering a new, captivating activity which, we hope, will become a hobby or passion for life for many students (and staff!).
